Mr. Cole's English classes

- TI-84 (Texas Instruments) graphing calculator (These can often be found greatly discounted in August at Target and office supply stores. The TI-84 Plus C is the best option, but a TI-84 will also suffice.)
- 1 package 8 count AAA Duracell batteries
- 24 pencils

- 1 one-inch ring binder
- 1 package pink erasers

Algebra 2:
